Volunteers Urgently Needed!

The Food For Kids Program began as a court project several years ago, and it has now been created as an individual not-for-profit organization. Throughout the school year, volunteers pack non-perishable food for food-insecure-children of the Washingtonville School District for them to take home so that they have food for the weekend and holidays.

During the summer, volunteers make sandwiches and hot lunches and bring this food out to several distribution points in the community, along with food for breakfast.

Volunteers are needed on **Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays** from 8:30 to 10:30 a.m. at the High School to help making sandwiches. Volunteers are also needed to bring the food out to the distribution sites. The program runs from **June 27 to August 26**.

Please make a commitment today to volunteer – perhaps a week or two, perhaps pick a day of the week and commit to showing up that day for each of the nine weeks. Put it on your calendar before the summer slips away.
