## Did You Know?

The New York Court assesses each member \$3.00 to fund the Marie C. Curry Seminary Fund.

Each Autumn, the State officers travel all over New York State to attend CDA memorial Masses to pray for the members who have died during the previous year. At that time the bishop of each diocese is given a check for the seminary – in YOUR name. This past weekend, State Regent Theresa Duran reported that each New York diocese received \$1500. Awesome!

The \$3.00 per member assessment for our court -- 125 (plus or minus) members – is paid from the general fund, and our members do not pay for this separately. A member of our court only pays for State and National Dues. Any assessments and National insurance (\$55 per court) is paid for by the court.

Our court had the privilege of hosting the Memorial Mass for the Past Regents and Officers Chapter for the Archdiocese. Pat Cooney was the Banner Bearer. Sue Wilson was drafted to be the Ceremonial Coordinator, and she did a terrific job. Baptism by fire!
