

Dear St. Mary's Family,

One of the central aspects of our priestly life is the annual retreat. Church Law strongly recommends getting time for vacation but mandates the retreat. In fact, there are times when the diocese will ask us about when we had our last retreat and where it was.

This week from January 22-27th, I will be away on retreat. A lot of priests will go to a monastery or other retreat center to spend that time of prayer and rest. The Institute for Priestly Formation every year hosts a retreat for vocation directors at Bethany Retreat Center in Tampa, Florida. Having spent five years as the director of vocations for the archdiocese I am grandfathered into the retreat, so that is where I will be. Not a bad spot for the end of January!

We think of a retreat as a time of rest and that certainly is true. But more importantly, it is the time we get to spend with Jesus. For many years I have observed the practice of turning off my cell phone for the week so that my time with the Lord is not interrupted. It is in this time of silence and prayer that God is truly heard and it is so important that we cherish and honor this.

Please be assured of my prayers for you in my time away. I ask for your prayers, as well, during this week. I hope to return revitalized and refreshed so that I can continue to serve you to the best of my ability.
