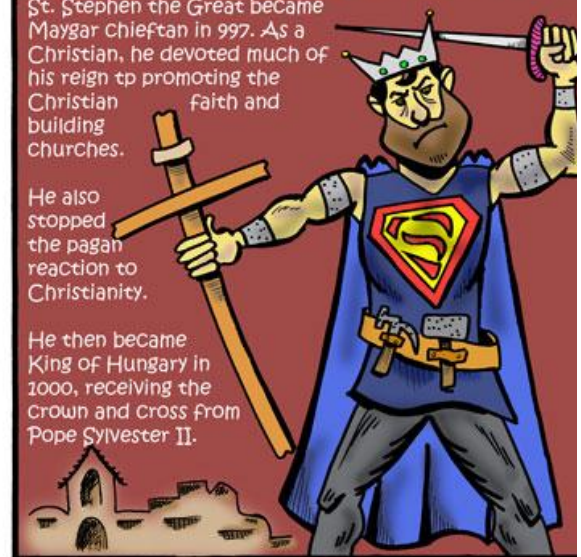
SAINTS FUN FACTS

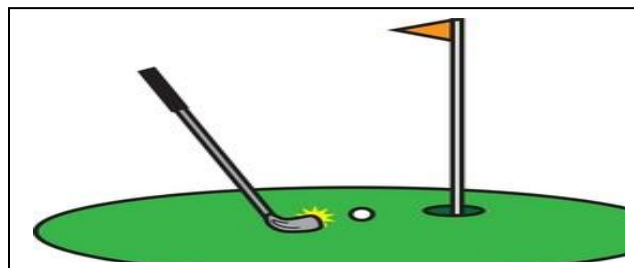


