

## . <u>Catholicism 101 –</u> RCIA Classes to begin Sept. 12 2022

## Religious Education News




The 2022-2023 Program will open the week of September 11.








## CATHOLIC CHARITIES' 16TH ANNUAL GOLF FOR CHARITY OUTING
