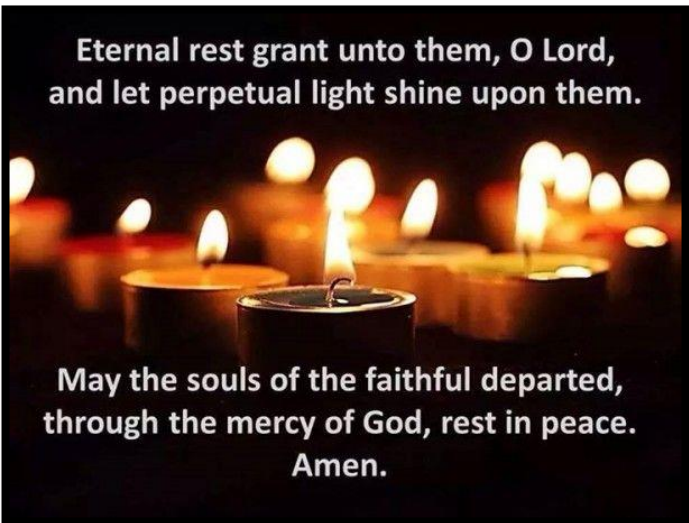

HORIZONS YOUTH GROUP HIKE

The plan was to go to Lake Minnewaska and after the hike we would have Mass on the mountain which would fulfill that week's Sunday obligation. OFFICE OF RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

MASS CARD REMINDERS:

If you forget your card, have the priest or deacon sign a parish bulletin- include your name. A slip of paper, signed by a priest or deacon, with the date and student's name is acceptable. Cards from previous weeks WILL NOT be accepted. Cards are to be placed in the designated bin and NOT in the collection basket - attendance will not count. Bulletins from another parish must be signed by a priest or deacon. Be sure your name is on the bulletin for credit. ALL Home Study students are to be present for Mass as part of the Home Study program. Lack of consistent Mass attendance will result in the return to in person class room study. Goes without saying that those preparing for a sacrament: Confirmation or First Communion should have consistent Mass attendance. Friendly reminder that only the student is to place the card in the collection bin!

FROM THE DESK OF FR. CHRIS

Dear St. Mary's Family,

Several of you have approached me about new Eucharistic ministers, lectors and altar servers. If you are interested in serving please sign up on our parish website. There will be a time scheduled for a practice before there is a formal induction as a new Eucharistic minister, lector or altar server.

Some parishioners and members of the staff have spoken with me about the current seating arrangement in the church. The left side which is for those unmasked with no social distancing has grown quite a bit and there was a question about modifying the seating. The thought is that the right back quarter of the church will be used for expanding the seating of the unmasked while the front right side will be for those who wish to remain masked and distanced. This new seating will go into effect the weekend of November 6-7. Of course, Tetreau Hall remains available as does sitting in the car listening to Mass on 88.1.

Just a reminder that when we are sitting in the car, although we can't stand or kneel, it is meant to be an extension of the church so we should do our best to be attentive to the readings and the prayers so we can get the most out of our experience of worship. Similarly it's good for all of us to remember that when we are on line to receive Communion we should be focusing on the extraordinary gift we are going to receive trying to avoid unnecessary distractions. The period after receiving Communion is the most privileged time of the week where we are physically united to the Lord. This should be a time, as much as possible, for quiet reflection as we seek to hear the voice of God with the ear of our heart. These reminders are as much for me as they are for you since it's easy to forget or take for granted the incredible gift of the Eucharist. When we come to Mass, priest and people alike, we want to get the most out of it as it is the strength we need to face the challenges of the coming week, assured that we face them with Jesus.

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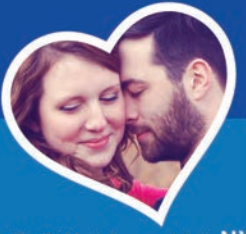

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
