## SAINTS FUN FACTS





November is fundamentally a month of remembrance. We start the month by recalling all those heroes of our faith, those men and women down through the centuries, who have shown us what a disciple should be, as we celebrate All Saints Day. The very next day we remember all those that have gone before us marked with the sign of faith, who still await the coming of the Kingdom.
