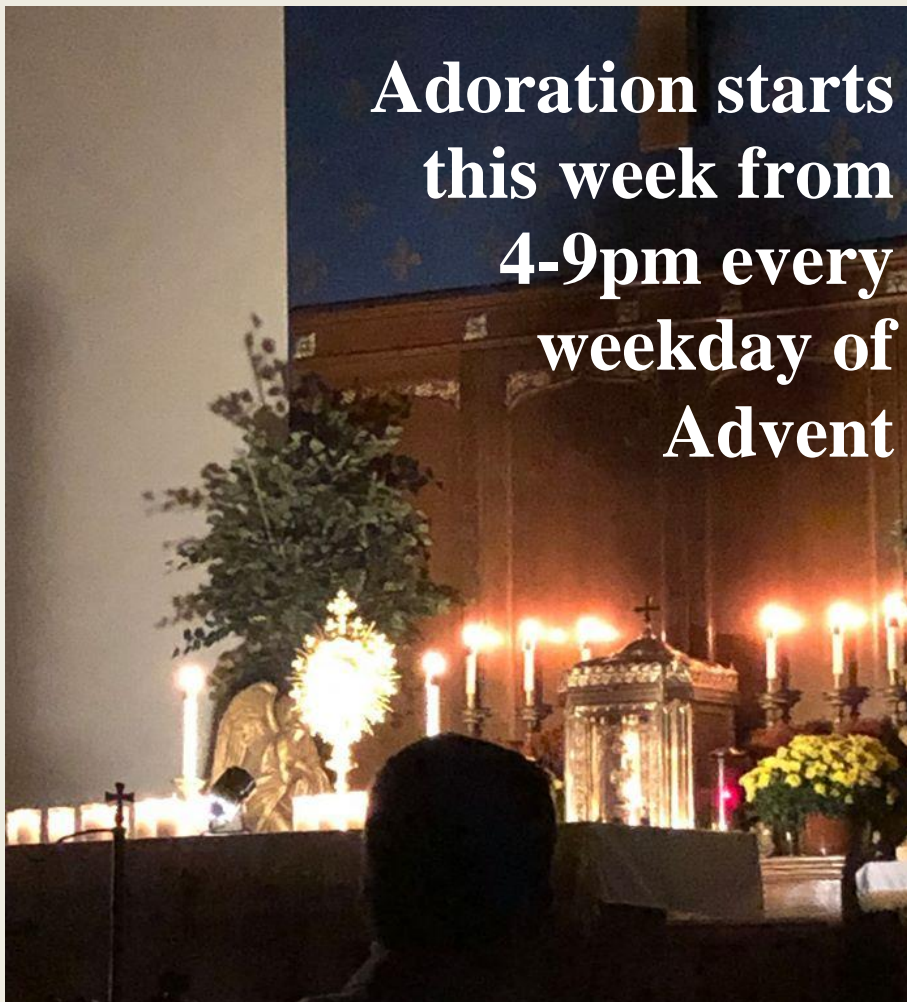

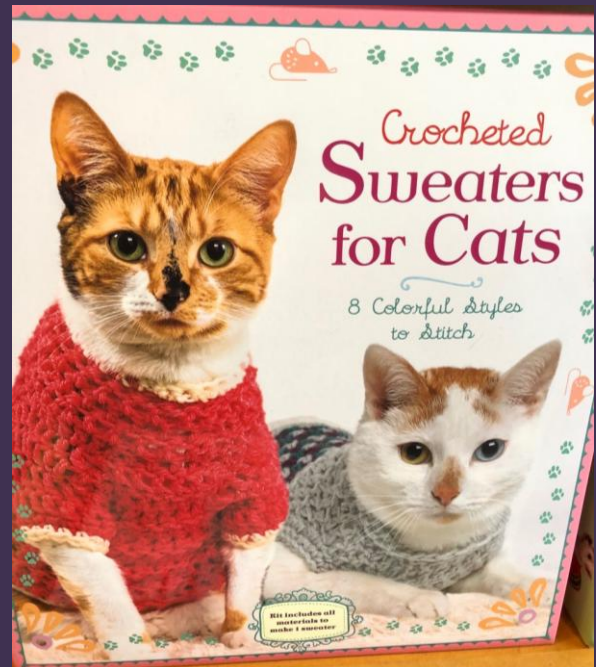

Parish Counseling Network

Sometimes this time of year can be rough..... Parishioners have access to short term counseling developed by Catholic Charities that offers access to more than 120 licensed mental health professionals. Those who wish to can receive help through issues with marital problems, parenting, eldercare, job loss or bereavement. Any type of crises can be successfully improved by short-term therapy with experienced counselors. Parishioners are eligible for a maximum of 6 counseling sessions. The fee is only \$10 per session. It also helps pastors secure the most effective & appropriate care for their parishioners.
